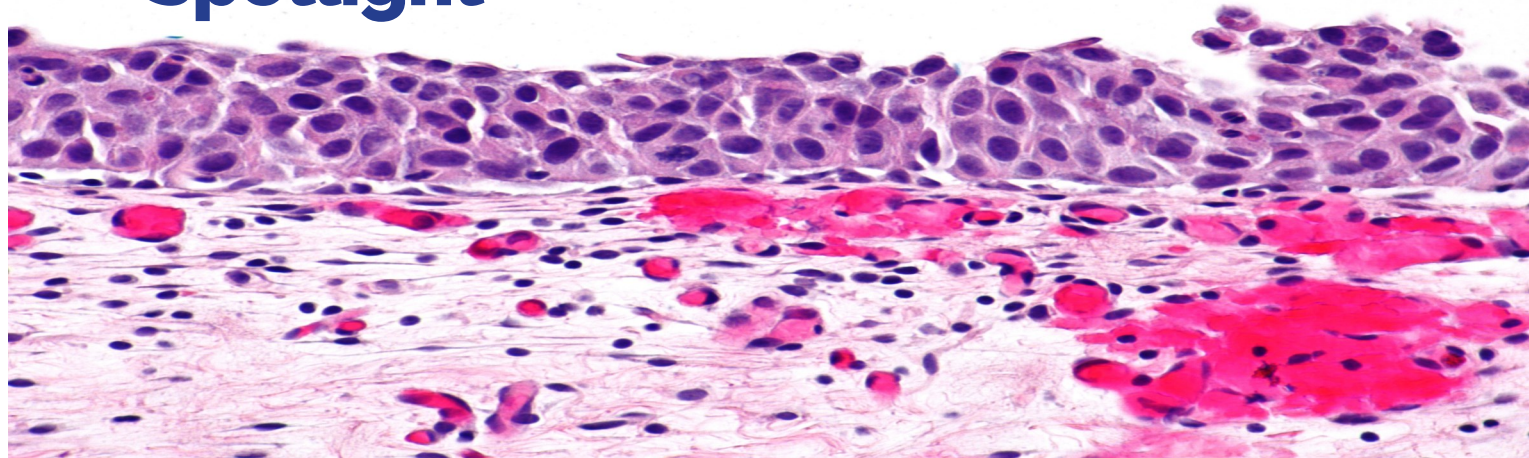

Abstracting Tip

Use primary site code C678, overlapping lesion of the bladder, when:

- There is a single tumor or noncontiguous tumors involving the bladder and one or both ureters
- AND
- The histology is 8120/2, urothelial carcinoma in situ (flat tumor) AND
- No other urinary organs are involved.

Refer to "Priority for Coding Primary Site" for urinary sites in the 2018 Solid Tumor Rules. According to Rule M5, these conditions constitute a single primary.

NOTE: These instructions do not apply to noninvasive papillary carcinoma (8130/2). Do NOT code to C688 or C689, overlapping, urinary sites NOS.

Question missed the most on the Colon SSDI Quiz

Question 13-41% of registrars chose the correct answer-Path report from surgical resection on a rectum cancer states the tumor is less than 0.1 cm from the right anterior mesorectal margin. How would you code Circumferential Resection Margin SSDI?

Correct Answer-0.9 Per SSDI Manual Version 2.0 page 102 Note 5 states The CRM may be referred to as Mesenteric (mesocolon) (mesorectal) margin. Note 7 page 102 states If the value is recorded in Centimeters, multiply by 10 to get the value in Millimeters (mm). 0.1 cm = 1.0 mm. Page 21 states Record the lab value as one less than stated when a value is reported as "less than X," and as one more than stated when a value is reported as "more than X." One less or one more may refer to a whole number (1), or a decimal (0.1), depending on the code structure of the field. Less than 1.0 mm=0.9
