- ODS-C or ODS credential change The National Cancer Registrars Association (NCRA) and its Council on Certification have updated the credential name of certified tumor registrar (CTR) to oncology data specialist (ODS). The new name better aligns with the evolving scope of practice of cancer registrars and current professional practice terminology. The use of the new credential began Jan. 1. Upcoming training

The truth about SEER Summary Stage Training

- Summary Stage 2 Regional by direct extension is not applicable for:
 - Cervical lymph nodes and unknown primary (C760)
 - HemeRetic (C421)
- If direct extension of the primary tumor into a regional lymph node, code as involved (Stage 3), not stage 2
- An in situ diagnosis can only be made microscopically, so if in situ, the diagnostic confirm must be 1 histology
- Autopsy reports are used in Summary Stage just as are pathology reports. Apply the same rules for inclusion
- T, N, and, M information may be used to assign Summary Stage when it's the only information available
- . Death certificate only (DCO) cases are assigned Summary Stage 9 only
- A tumor which is "attached" to another organ is not considered involved (see ambiguous terminology section
- A tumor which is "impinging upon" another organ is considered involved (see ambiguous terminology section
