

Determining if nodes are regional or distant for AJCC can be difficult, especially when your physicians don't assign a stage, or they all assign differently. Recently I've received more than one question about level IV neck nodes and lung cancer; are they considered regional N3 nodes, or are they too high in the neck and considered metastatic M1?

Table 36.1 in AJCC defines lung lymph node station 1 nodes as those that fall between the lower margin of the cricoid cartilage and the clavicles.

When researching what a level IV neck node is considered, you'll see they are called lower jugular nodes, deep cervical and even supraclavicular. AJCC is clear that supraclavicular nodes are N3, but lower jugular and deep cervical aren't specifically spelled out in the chapter.

My tip to you, when trying to determine things like this, is to look at the pictures available in the AJCC manual, and use Google (of course, making sure the resource you're looking at is a reputable source). Below are the resources I used in confirming that neck level IV nodes are considered N3 nodes for lung cancers, in addition to Table 36.1 in AJCC and Figure 36.1.

Level IV: lower internal jugular (deep cervical) chain

- · superiorly: inferior border of the cricoid cartilage
- · inferiorly: level of the clavicle
- · anteriorly: anterior border of the sternocleidomastoid muscle
- posterolaterally: oblique line drawn through the posterolateral edge of the sternocleidomastoid muscle and the lateral edge of the anterior scalene muscle²
- · medially: medial border of the common carotid artery
- includes medial supraclavicular nodes including Virchow node ¹

So, with those resources, you can clearly see that the lower jugular nodes, or deep cervical chain, fall between the lower border of the cricoid and above the clavicles, therefore meeting the definition of a lung station1 node. Level IV neck nodes for lung cancer will always be N3. And remember, N3 is automatically a summary stage of 7 for lung 2


