For those that have been an ICRA member for a few years, you may remember back to the 2021 ICRA conference when we discussed class of case and how it applies to different scenarios...specifically, when a patient has treatment at one facility, and goes to another facility for further recommendations. Well, in 2023 NCDB had changed their instructions (via CAnswer Forum posts and a direct email with me) and I shared that clarification with all of you.

Welcome to 2025 - another change!



I personally feel this aligns with STORE instructions better, and is the direction initially shared in 2021. Effective immediately, the following direction should be applied. Additionally, NCDB is having discussions about getting this scenario added to STORE.

Surveillance, contraindication, or refusal of treatment only affect class of case if that is the one and only treatment option/modality provided.

Treatment Decisions and Class of Case

Provided below are the only classes of case that would be assigned for the different scenarios listed.

- Decision for active surveillance only
 - 00 Diagnosed at your facility, active surveillance chosen elsewhere
 - 14 Diagnosed at your facility and active surveillance chosen there
 - 22 Diagnosed elsewhere, active surveillance chosen at your facility
- Patient had surgery at an outside facility, refused adjuvant therapy at your facility
 - 14 The facility the diagnosed and performed the surgery
 - 30 Facility that recommended adjuvant therapy and patient refused
- Surgery at your facility, consult with oncology at outside facility that said no adjuvant therapy needed
 - 14 Diagnosed and surgery performed at your facility
 - 30 Outside facility consulted with the patient and provided no further treatment
- Patient diagnosed and neoadjuvant outside, planned surgery cancelled at your facility due to poor response
 - 14 Diagnosed and neoadjuvant therapy provided at outside facility
 - 30 Facility originally planning surgery but cancelled. No treatment was provided

Bottom line - once a patient has received treatment, if he/she goes to another facility, that 2nd facility MUST provide treatment to be an analytic class of case.




